Monona Grove School District: Monona Grove School District has an opening for a .60 FTE School Social Worker at Glacial Drumlin School. Position begins approximately August 16, 2021. Successful applicant may be required to attend training sessions over the summer.

Overview:

The Monona Grove School District is seeking a qualified School Social Worker.

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with building staff to establish and maintain a positive mental health and behavioral culture in the school.
- Communicate effectively with families, particularly as related to challenging student circumstances and issues.
- Participate in a professional learning community; provide in-service training for other staff as appropriate.
- Work closely with grade level, student services, and leadership teams in using data to plan interventions, programming, and advancing district priorities including ICS for Equity and Mental Health and Wellness.
- Coordinate AODA prevention efforts.
- Collaborate with school improvement teams.
- Facilitate/participate in structured problem solving process.
- Design and implement effective interventions for students, including consulting with and training of staff on monitoring fidelity of implementation.
- Serve on school and district crisis response team.
- Conduct small group and individual counseling.
- Consult with outside providers (medical professionals, therapists, etc.) on student needs.
- Connect students/families with outside resources (county, community, etc.) as appropriate.
- Coordinate and lead Restorative Practices
- Attend work regularly.

- Knowledge of common academic assessment instruments as well as universal screening and progress monitoring for student mental health.
