What is Project AWARE?

In 2023, the Department of Public Instruction was awarded a 5-year federal grant through Project AWARE. The project aims to build CESA capacity to support schools in improving their school mental systems, with the goal of increasing health and educational equity across Wisconsin.

Training Opportunities

CESA staff will provide training opportunities in a variety of school mental health topics, including: mental health literacy, the Wisconsin School Mental Health Framework, continuous improvement in school mental health, and best practices in school mental health.



Technical Assistance

CESA staff will provide coaching, consultation, and support to school or district teams in developing the building blocks of high quality school mental health systems. Services will focus on using action-oriented tools to move teams towards their improvement goals.

Networked Improvement Community

Experienced school mental health teams will engage in a shared learning process using improvement science to positively impact a common, statewide challenge in school mental health.
