Plans for Next Year: 2019-2020

- All Wisconsin 21st CCLC sites will be provided a license to use Cayen Systems and expected to enter data
- Initial training of Cayen Systems will occur in September/October with regular webinars throughout the year
- UWGB will conduct monthly data checks and connect with sites to encourage regular data collection

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Plans for Next Year: 2019-2020

- At a minimum, sites will be required to enter and certify APR data into Cayen (this will replace submission to 21APR)
- Sites will be encouraged (but not required) to enter data more regularly and participate in optional components (family and student surveys, grades, assessment scores)
