



NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVIEW ACADEMIC STANDARDS

On January 22, 2018, the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction will start a review of the School Counseling Standards for Student Success. To ensure that Wisconsin Academic Standards prepare all students to be college and career ready, these standards represent the common skills, knowledge, and dispositions that are necessary for students to succeed. Wisconsin Academic Standards are reviewed, revised, or both on an ongoing basis, and their adoption and use by schools is voluntary in state statute.

PUBLIC COMMENT

All comments received within 30 days of this notice will be reviewed and considered by the Standards Review Council (SRC). Members of the SRC are selected from a group of individuals that represent education, business, state leadership, communities, and parents throughout the state.
