738 students served-88% Eligible for Free or reduced lunch (41%)  
 630  
 108 male

**Academics**  
 ACT Participation  
 77 InSPIRE participants took the ACT in the 2012-13 or 2013-14 school years  
 Average composite score was 14.92 (22.04)

**WKCE Scores**  
 Percentiles for WKCE tests (50<sup>th</sup> percentile)  
 Reading mean = 18.22  
 Language Arts mean = 20.53  
 Math mean = 17.19  
 Science mean = 16.53  
 Social Studies mean = 18.62

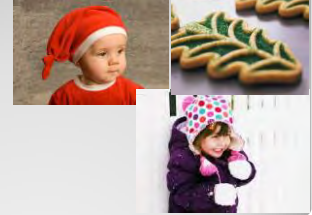
**Attendance**  
 Attendance (2012-13 school year)
