Data Collection

Please review the information on Data Collection for the 2014-15 school year at http://sspw.dpi.wi.gov/sspw_sndata. A national initiative led by the National Association of School Nurses (NASN) and the National Association of State School Nurse Consultants (NASSNC) to standardize and simplify data collection throughout schools in the United States is beginning. The new tool includes data in 3 areas including health personnel, chronic conditions, and health office visit dispositions by the Registered Nurse (RN). That's it--only three sections. **Grant districts are expected to complete this data collection tool by June 19, 2015.**

I will be contacting you by phone during January to make sure you are set up to collect and report the data specific to chronic conditions (questions 7-12).
