

## **License Based on Reciprocity Pathway**

This pathway allows teachers and administrators who hold a valid license in good standing from another state and have at least one year of experience under the license in that state to apply for a Wisconsin license.

## **Requirements for Wisconsin School Districts**

- Verify that the educator holds a valid license in good standing from another state
- Verify that the educator has at least one year of experience under the license in that state

## **Requirements for Educator**

- Hold a valid teacher or administrator license in good standing from another state
- Have at least one year of experience as a teacher or administrator under the license in that state

## **TO APPLY** for a license in this Pathway, a **License Based on Reciprocity applicant** must:

- 1. **APPLY** for the license using the Educator Licensing Online (ELO) application system by following the directions at https://dpi.wi.gov/tepdl/elo/other/reciprocity
- 2. **SUBMIT** a copy of the educator's valid license from another state
- 3. **SUBMIT** documentation of at least one year of professional experience with a <u>PI-1613 Employment Verification</u> form (download at <a href="https://dpi.wi.gov/tepdl/elo/supplementary-forms">https://dpi.wi.gov/tepdl/elo/supplementary-forms</a>)
