



License Based on Reciprocity Pathway

This pathway allows teachers and administrators who hold a valid license in good standing from another state and have at least one year of experience under the license in that state to apply for a Wisconsin license.

Requirements for Wisconsin School Districts

- Verify that the educator holds a valid license in good standing from another state
- Verify that the educator has at least one year of experience under the license in that state

Requirements for Educator

- Hold a valid teacher or administrator license in good standing from another state
- Have at least one year of experience as a teacher or administrator under the license in that state

TO APPLY for a license in this Pathway, a **License Based on Reciprocity applicant** must:

1. **APPLY** for the license using the Educator Licensing Online (ELO) application system by following the directions at <https://dpi.wi.gov/tepd/elo/other/reciprocity>
2. **SUBMIT** a copy of the educator's valid license from another state
3. **SUBMIT** documentation of at least one year of professional experience with a [PI-1613 Employment Verification](#) form (download at <https://dpi.wi.gov/tepd/elo/supplementary-forms>)
