

- A supportive and engaged community







## ACP Statutory Requirements

§. 115.28(59) ACADEMIC AND CAREER PLANNING:

(a) 2017–18 school year: every school board provides academic and career planning services to ALL students in grades 6 to 12

DPI is to provide:

(a) Rule

(b) Tool

(c) PD/Guidance/Training
