

- Reporting of all zero values
- Nebulous guidance in school form
- Misfiring skip logic warnings




- ✓ What does it mean when an LEA's CRDC data is certified?
- An LEA certifies their data when submission is complete.
- Certification means they are certifying the data are accurate.
- If LEAs cannot submit all data, they have two options:
 - Action Plans
 - Quick Plans

- Issues unique to Wisconsin:
 - Assistance on Entering Data: There was confusion concerning why the percentage completion during submission was different across LEAs, when the same sets of data were being entered for all LEAs.
 - The percentage completion for each LEA varied based on the number of 0s entered for certain elements
 - Percentage completion also varied by grades offered
- Resources:
- Skipped Field Warnings TA document
- PSC is also creating a Skip Logic TA document (to be released in the future)



• SCED Codes:

- Wisconsin requested a published list of SCED codes applicable to the CRDC
- Resources: PSC is creating a SCED Codes TA document

Policy Questions:

- Program Enrollment (PENR)
 - 504-only students should be included in PENR-4 in the overall count of students.
- Virtual Schools
 - Virtual schools should be included in reporting



Staff/School Security

 Support staff and contracted workers should be included if they fit within the reported categories (teachers, counselors, support services staff, security staff)

Harassment & Bullying

 Support staff and contracted workers should be included if they fit within the reported categories (teachers, counselors, support services staff, security staff)

Post-Collection Data Corrections



- Starting in July, selected LEAs were contacted for post-collection data corrections.
- Selected LEAs were given the opportunity to review their data and make additional corrections.
- In Wisconsin, 146 LEAS were selected.
