

## **SAFE Updates At A Glance**

Initially launched in 2010, the Secure Access File Exchange (SAFE) is a secure, flexible, web-based tool developed by DPI that allows authorized district and school users to access their confidential data files and reports that DPI has shared with them such as the preliminary accountability report cards. Access is managed locally by the SAFE Application Administrator in each district.

## **Coming Soon!**

When you log in to SAFE, you will notice a new, clean user experience with updated menus and navigation. Security roles and the process to request access remain the same.

Reports are organized into tiles by topic, and broken down by the relevant school year.

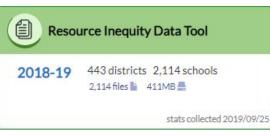
Users can view all report topics from one home page, including topics that they may not have access to yet. Simply click the Request Access link to ask for access.
