Subject: WISEdash Public Portal

WISEdash for Districts

Last fall, the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) released the Wisconsin Information System for Education Dashboard, or WISEdash, statewide. WISEdash for Districts is only accessible through DPI's secure landing portal, Secure Home, which requires a login and password. WISEdash - the statewide data warehouse - provides all school districts access to a variety of dashboards including: Enrollment, Attendance, Assessments (WSAS, ACT, AP), ACCESS for ELLs, Student Growth Percentiles, HS Completion, Postsecondary Enrollment from the National Student Clearinghouse, and a Student Profile/Student Search. Earlier this month, the Dropout Early Warning System (DEWS) was added to WISEdash, and more dashboards are planned for this school year as well. Data are critical to your district, school, and classroom decision-making and WISEdash is designed to support that goal.

WISEdash Public Portal

Now, one year later, DPI is preparing to launch a new data dashboard to the public. The WISEdash Public Portal will replace WINSS over time as the public's dashboard. The WISEdash Public Portal is now available as of October 9, 2013 at <http://wisedash.dpi.wi.gov>. WISExplore

Accessing data is only one step. Just as important is your ability to think about and work with data. To that end, DPI and the CESA Statewide Network (CSN) collaborated in the Fall of 2012 to create WISExplore (http://wise.dpi.wi.gov/wise_explorehome), a consistent data inquiry process linked directly to WISEdash. Dr. Judy Sargent from CESA 7 leads a team that is a cross section of staff from the CSN. They are developing "digital data retreats" within WISExplore. The approach is a blend of face-to-face and e-learning modules, modeling contemporary classroom instructional practices. Our aim with WISExplore is to help educators and administrators make sense of the data they are seeing in order to facilitate a statewide culture of data-driven decision making.
