WISEid: Bug Fix--New Entity IDs in Person Upload for districts initiate Change Request	We had an issue that when new person records were created by upload with an Entity ID supplied, the ID was ignored. We fixed this problem, and the system now correctly creates a Change Request for DPI to review.
WISEid: Revised Potential Duplicate job logic	We have created a job to automatically create a potential duplicate request when there are exact matches on Person First Name, Last Name, Birthdate, and Gender. This is limited to only when the person's age is 21 years or under. DPI CST will be reviewing these potential duplicates as time permits and might contact districts with questions to verify which are truly duplicates or not.
WISEid & WISEstaff: Releasing Notification System pilot	<p>On 1/15/19, we will be allowing districts to pilot our new Notification System. <p>WISEid: Upgraded Kendo to latest version</p>	<p>We upgraded the user interface (UI) in the WISEid application to be the most recent. It will enhance compatibility in newer browser versions, but it could cause issues for older, unsupported browsers. We recommend the latest versions of browsers for the best compatibility.</p>
<p>WISEid: Bug Fix--Uploads work with Edge browser.</p>	<p>We fixed an issue that was preventing uploads from working in Microsoft Edge browser.</p>

<p>WISEstaff: Adjusted Audit Results 'Report Content Type' names to match official report names</p>	<p>In Audit Results, we updated the Report Content Type in the table to match the description in the 2018-19 School District Educator Licensing Audits letter (Click PDF) on at the top of the page. Last year these did not line up, and users were confused.</p>
<p>WISEstaff: Updated Audit Letter</p>	<p>In Audit Results, we updated the the 2018-19 School District Educator Licensing Audits letter (Click PDF) at the top of the page to reflect the current collection year. Descriptions of various audit reports have been expanded with more detail.</p>
<p>WISEstaff: Data Quality Check #09 - Validation messages for unexpected increase or decrease in Local and Total years of experience</p>	<p>We created new validations to check the quality of your staff data:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Warning message #4054: "Total Years Experience is less than expected based on experience reported in previous collection year." ● Warning message #4055: "Local Years Experience is less than expected based on experience reported in previous collection year." ● Warning message #4056: "Total Years Experience is greater than expected based on experience reported in previous collection year." ● Warning message #4057: "Local Years Experience is greater than expected based on experience reported in previous collection year."

	<p>All rules compare against the most recent previous year's records in WISEstaff (back to 2014-15) and adjust years to what it should be currently in calculations. If it's determined previous data was incorrect, you can do a Data Errata letter or ignore. In such cases, acknowledge the warning if it is correct this year. Future work will allow you to see the historical data to view the source.</p>
<p>WISEstaff: Redesigned Roadmap and added instructional verbiage</p>	<p>We renamed our Annual Staff Collection Roadmap to Annual Staff Collection Checklist. We also redesigned it to be vertical in order of the steps and provided additional steps to clarify tasks. This enhancement should help agencies better understand tasks and the order in which to complete them for the staff collection, saving hours of time and confusion.</p>
<p>WISEstaff: Retained state of Staff Collection Checklist section</p>	<p>We defaulted the Annual Staff Collection Checklist on the WISEstaff tab homepage to an open state. We made the checklist display a user-saved setting to collapse or open the section, meaning if you collapse it, it will stay collapsed the next time you log in. This should balance the needs of advanced users who don't want to see this often vs. new users who need to see this often. It should save users a few minutes of time each time they log in to complete staff work.</p>
