WISEid: Change button names for Change Request Appeal process	The options that DPI will have to process an appealed Change Request will now be called Approve Appeal and Deny Appeal.
WISEid: Fix Person Change History to delete second WISEid that carried over from original WSLS conversion process	Fixed an issue in Person Change History where some WSLS conversion records showed another person's WISEid as part of the history.
WISEid: Add instructional content to Edit Entity ID pop-up	To provide clarification on what's required to successfully submit an Entity ID change request, we have added instructions to WISEstaff. After you submit an Entity ID Change Request through Person/Staff Edit screens you will see a new text box describing how things work and what to expect.
WISEstaff: Add the certification deadline date to the checklist	Changed the Staff Collection Checklist steps 2e and 3f so they show the Certification Deadline date after the certification start date window has opened for the school year.
