WISE DPI: Added Choice schools and Local Person ID type to Resolve Duplicates filter lists	Help desk users can now filter potential duplicates by individual Choice schools and Staff or Student Local Person ID types on the Resolve Duplicates screen, letting them more quickly identify and resolve duplicate WISEid records.
WISEid/WISEstaff: Added additional information on agencies not currently open	<p>We added expanded descriptions for agencies not currently open on the Change Agency page.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Agencies that plan to open next year now have the description “Opening in: YYYY-YYYY” ● Agencies that are currently closed with no planned opening date now have the description “Closed: YYYY-YYYY” <p>There is a known data issue with when agencies open and close which we currently plan to fix in the 7/16 release.</p>
WISEstaff: Added Data Quality Statewide Report - No Teachers at School Report	We added a new report for help desk staff to verify the reasons that an agency has no teachers at a school.
WISEstaff: Added Data Quality Statewide Report - Potential Salary or Fringe Issues	We also added a new report so that help desk staff can more easily identify salary or fringe benefit data issues to help agencies resolve those issues.

WISEstaff: Revised display of dashboard counts

We improved the appearance of Staff Data Quality dashboards to help you more quickly identify if there are significant changes between years.

These improvements include:

- Dashboards no longer show bar charts. Instead, data appears from the previous three years with a green arrow indicating an increase or a red arrow indicating a decrease.
- To the right of the arrow icons, the number and percentage of the change appears.
- You can click on an individual year within each dashboard tile to see detailed data reports.
