

WISEdata Release Notes: 8/31/17

WORK ITEM	Description/Comments
API: Updated SIS vendor access	We made modifications to SIS vendor access for 2017-18 data to accommodate special education-only vendors.
DPI Calculation: New Effective Date logic in place	To prevent overlapping enrollment issues, DPI has new calculations in place to set Effective Dates for student school associations (sSA) and special education program associations (sSEPA). If overlaps can't be resolved by LEAs, Effective Date logic will set Effective Begin and End Dates for enrollments.
DPI Calculations: New Effective Dates in place for Accountable School calculations	All accountable school calculations run at DPI have been reworked to use the school association (sSA) Effective Dates. Additionally, for a specific sSA, we're checking to make sure we have the current accountable school at the time of the specific enrollment.
DPI Calculation: Expected Transfer Agency is appropriately calculated.	We reviewed the logic for the DPI calculation of Expected Transfer Agency to ensure it is correct when using the new sSA Effective Dates.
DPI Calculation: Count Inclusion statuses reviewed with new Effective Dates in place	With the new sSA Effective Dates in place, we reviewed the logic for determining count inclusion for 3rd Friday of September and Oct. 1 Child Count, as well as for Current statuses.
WDP: Bug Fix--School Directory data is validated in nightly 24 hr. job	The 24 hr. validation job wasn't bringing in updates to School Directory, but this has been resolved.
WDP: Now multiple programs can be accepted for one section in certain cases.	We removed the L1 validation that restricted multiple Programs in a Section to accommodate cases where two programs can apply to one Section, such as Dual Enrollment and Bilingual.
WDP: New validations for sSEPA, sPA, and sAR	We developed an L1 validation to make sure the

will use LEA ID and not a School ID.	Education Org. property is populated correctly in the sSEPA, sPA, and sAR. These resources now use an LEA ID and not a School ID.
WDP: New validation 6373	We have a new L2 validation rule 6373 - Enrollment period totally encompassed within another primary enrollment period. As per new sSA Effective Date logic, DPI will remove records: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • when we have enrollment records with the exact same entry and exit date • totally encompassed with another primary enrollment record • bad data- when exit date is in the past
WDP: New validation 6374	We have a new L2 validation rule, 6374 - Enrollment period selected over another primary enrollment period. This works in conjunction with the validation logic above.
WDP: New validation 6469	We have a new L2 validation rule- 6469 - No overlap of enrollment periods is allowed. This works with the new Effective Date logic and the validation rule above.
WDP: Enhanced performance of message updates	We improved the performance when displaying updated messages, so they should appear faster.
WDP: Removed Discipline option in WDP metrics for Choice schools	For the Choice school agency type, Choice users shouldn't see Discipline in the Collection drop down in WDP metrics, so we removed it.
WDP: Student Details topics link to WISEdata webpages.	We linked a few topics and data elements in the Student Detail screen to their coordinating WISEdata webpages for an easy jump to more information. We will add more links in the future.
Discipline: Two Discipline charts now show counts by action, not by student.	Action by Grade and Action By Disability Status reports now reflect counts by discipline action, not by student.
Discipline: Discipline Action Export file has a clearer description for Modified Term Type.	The "Modified Term Type?" column on the Discipline Action Export file now uses the short

	description instead of the ID.
Discipline: Incident Export file shows info even when there's no SDIA.	In the Discipline Incident Export file, even when there is no student discipline incident association, we will still display record information.
Discipline: Bug Fix--Discipline charts now show SwD and SwoD appropriately.	Discipline charts 4 and 6 for SwD and SwoD (count) weren't showing up if there was no student discipline incident association, but this has been fixed.
API: L1 Validations are sending accurate messages to SIS vendors and users.	Level 1 validations were sending generic error messages back to users/SIS vendors, but we've reviewed L1 messages to be helpful and specific.
WDP: All sSEPAs accepted properly	Previously we had an issue where if an sSEPA was effective for only one day, it was filtered out of the database, but this was resolved.
DPI Calculation: Effective Date logic allows for one-day enrollments.	The data warehouse filter for the new Effective Dates was modified to be Effective End Date >= Effective Begin Date instead of Effective End Date > Effective Begin Date to account for one-day enrollments.
WDP: Bug Fix--6645 now works appropriately.	The validation rule 6645 was showing up for districts even when the student was not enrolled, but this was fixed.
WDP: New Admin page to add data element page links	We added an Admin page in WDP for administrative roles to add WISEdata data element webpage links to data properties.
DPI Calculation: Bug Fix--sSA Effective Dates logic works with Choice school enrollments for PPP students.	There was an error in the Effective Dates when a Choice enrollment aligned with a public school claiming PPP=True and a subsequent PPP=False was present. The public PPP=True was not getting truncated appropriately, but this was resolved.
