

WISEdata Release Notes: 1/4/18

Title	Description/Comments
WDP: Modified logic in rule 6499	We added an SSA enrollment record condition check to validation rule 6499, so the rule doesn't throw if the SSA has been removed/deleted.
WDP: Modified logic in rule 6575	We changed the logic for validation rule 6575 regarding expected transfers with ETC Exit Type because some districts were feeling they needed to alter enrollment information just to clear the error that was sometimes throwing inappropriately. The new logic corrects this.
WDP: Bug Fix--Rule 6480 is working properly now.	We had an issue where validation rule 6480 was not clearing when schools submitted the correct exit information, but this has been resolved now.
WDP: Bug Fix-- Rule 6601 works after logic modification.	We resolved an issue with validation rule 6601 throwing incorrectly by changing the rule's logic to check that sSEPA effective dates cover Oct. 1 before throwing.
WDP: Bug Fix--Rule 6613 works after logic modification.	We had a bug where rule 6613 was not clearing when School ID was not submitted and PPP = true. As PPP enrollments coincide with Choice enrollment, the Choice school may incorrectly be selected for comparison, so we've improved the logic check to ensure the rule works correctly now and identifies the right accountable school.
WDP: New Ed-Fi API Programs View	From the Student Detail screen, we added a toggle that allows users to see an API

It will display relevant WISEdata data elements followed by the Ed-Fi term with which SIS vendors may be more familiar and the value for each data element.</p>
<p>WDP: New Ed-Fi API Discipline View</p>	<p>From the Student Detail screen, we added a toggle that allows users to see an API Database view of the student’s discipline record for that school year, if applicable. It will display relevant WISEdata data elements followed by the Ed-Fi term with which SIS vendors may be more familiar and the value for each data element.</p>
<p>WDP: New Ed-Fi API Enrollment View</p>	<p>From the Student Detail screen, we added a toggle that allows users to see an API Database view of the student’s enrollment record for that school year. It will display relevant WISEdata data elements followed by the Ed-Fi term with which SIS vendors may be more familiar and the value for each data element.</p>
<p>WDP: New Ed-Fi API Special Education View</p>	<p>From the Student Detail Screen, we added a toggle that allows users to see an API Database view of the student’s special education record for that school year, if applicable. It will display relevant WISEdata</p>

<p>WDP: New Ed-Fi API Student View</p>	<p>From the Student Detail Screen, we added a toggle that allows users to see an API Database view of the student record for that school year. It will display relevant WISEdata data elements followed by the Ed-Fi term with which SIS vendors may be more familiar and the value for each data element.</p>
<p>WDP: Email alert when manual validation completes</p>	<p>We've implemented a new option to receive an email when triggering a manual validation. Emails will not send automatically on validation, but you can elect to receive an email by marking the checkbox by the Queue Validation button. The contact email text box will prefill with the WAMS email address of the person logged in, but the user can modify the address. Emails will NOT trigger for System jobs, only user-initiated validation jobs. Also note, you will have to select this option each time you trigger a manual validation if you wish to receive the email alert.</p>
<p>Discipline: Modified Discipline Action Export</p>	<p>We added the Last Name, First Name of the student tied to the Discipline Action in the downloadable export file.</p>
<p>WDP: Export screen now defaults to 'Show All' option.</p>	<p>When selecting 'Exports' from the menu in the WISEdata Portal, the default Collection filter drop-down is now 'Show All' instead of the previous default of 3rd Fri of September. This change allows a user to see more easily all the exports available.</p>
<p>WDP: Improved performance of student searches</p>	<p>We made some changes behind the scenes in the WISEdata Portal to improve the</p>

	performance and speed of student searches.
WDP: Access to Secure Home at logout	Instead of only being able to exit WISEdata, you will now have the option to log out or return to Secure Home.
WDP: Bug Fix--Removed export options from Data Quality metrics Collections drop-down	We had an issue where the exports for Validation Messages, Student Characteristics, Student Program Associations, and Student Special Education were appearing in the Collections drop-down on the Data Quality page in WISEdata Portal when those exports should not have appeared. We've removed them to resolve this issue.
WDP: Bug Fix-- 2016-17 school year displays in Student Details when it should.	We had a bug where in the WISEdata Portal Student Detail Search data was not displaying in the grid for the 2016-17 school year, but this has been corrected.
WDP: New columns in Student Details to show errors and warnings	We added three new columns to the right of the Birth Date column on the WISEdata Portal Student Details screen. Now by default, users will see columns for Errors, Warnings, and Total.
WDP: Warning metrics split into Acknowledged and Unacknowledged.	<p>We split the current 'Warning Count' indicator on the Data Quality page in the WISEdata Portal into two indicators. Now warnings show as 'Warning Count - Acknowledged' and 'Warning Count - Unacknowledged'.</p> <p>When users click one of the two indicators, the correct filter will be applied when navigating to the Validation Messages page.</p>
WDP: Bug fix-- HSC Export contains appropriate data	We had an issue in the High School Completion export where the column titled District Name contained the school name.

	<p>The column titled School Name also contained the school name. The columns titled District Code and School code both contained the district code. We've resolved the bug, so the export now contains the correct values.</p>
