

## WISEdata Release Notes: 4/27/17

WORK ITEM	Description/Comments
<p><b>*Note, the following Roster and Discipline items are listed to make you aware of development progress, but they are not yet in use in your SIS.</b></p> <p><b>Roster:</b> You can't delete an sSA that has a linked sSEPA record.</p>	<p>All sSEPA's moving forward will have an sSA relationship, so we know the specific enrollment tied to the sSEPA. If users attempt to delete an sSA, it would force them to remove the sSEPA and any other linked records prior to deleting the sSA.</p>
<p><b>Roster:</b> Bug Fix--Matched Ed-Fi staff terms with Roster database terms</p>	<p>Ed-Fi Staff terms were mismatched in the API and ODS, and all the records in ODS had isactive = 0: no data exists for Ed-Fi Staff Identification Code, but this has been fixed.</p>
<p><b>Discipline:</b> We now have rules to check for behavior values.</p>	<p>We now have a rule to check if the Behaviors value is missing. It returns an L1 validation only if the behaviors descriptor is missing because behaviors descriptor and the detailed description and serious bodily injury are all tied together.</p>
<p><b>Discipline:</b> Added metadata, so correct values will send to the API.</p>	<p>We added behavior, discipline type, and student participation code type metadata to the API database descriptor/type table(s) so that we have the correct values for sending data to the API. We also modified the validation descriptions.</p>
<p><b>WDP:</b> Records with certain errors will still be accepted into WISEdata.</p>	<p>We can now accept ACCESS score records when the following validation errors are present: 6414, 6415, 6416.</p>
<p><b>WDP:</b> All data will be checked in the nightly 24hr. validation run.</p>	<p>We had an issue where the nightly validation was only checking new data. Going forward, the nightly validation will pick all the data that was created/modified in the last 24hrs; this includes data that was already in ODS when schools trigger imports/validations.</p>
<p><b>WDP:</b> Bug Fix--6613 now throws appropriately.</p>	<p>6613 was throwing for other schools sharing a student that the grade level wasn't valid for the accountable school, but this is corrected.</p>

**Roster:** Any Roster endpoint with school year or a school year reference now has a rule to prevent inputting the wrong year.

Any Roster endpoint with school year or a school year reference now has a rule to prevent inputting the wrong school year of data going into the Ed-Fi API database that doesn't match that school year.
