

WISEdata Release Notes: 10/8/19

Title	Description/Comments
WDP: New validation message export	You can now use an export to quickly view validation messages related to demographics, enrollment, and academic records for students at a school. This can help save time troubleshooting related errors in these areas by viewing them all together instead of going to individual Student Detail screens.
WDP: School year now appears on the Student Detail screen	To make it easier to review the right data for a student, the school year you're viewing data for now appears at the top of the Student Detail screen.
WDP: Performance improvements for Student Detail screen	Performance issues that users experienced when viewing the Student Detail screen have been resolved.
WDP: Special Education export now includes SATA	A new column showing SATA results for a student is now available in Special Education exports.
WDP: Career Education snapshot acknowledgment no longer appears for K-8 schools	Users at K-8 schools no longer need to acknowledge the Career Education snapshot.
WDP: Revised validation rule 6751	Validation rule 6751 no longer fires for Department of Corrections or Department of Health Services, as those agencies are not required to submit discipline records.
WDP: Bug Fix--Validation rule 6761 now fires appropriately	Validation rule 6761 now appropriately fires for homeless program association records overlapping at the same school.

WDP: Bug Fix--Validation rules for language programs no longer appear for the wrong program type
