Title	Description/Comments
<p>WDP: Rule 6770 (v2.0) logic change</p>	<p>Rule 6770 previously threw an error if a Grades record wasn't submitted for a student in grades 9-12 with a recorded student section for the course if the student was enrolled in a course for the minimum amount of time to receive a grade.</p> <p>Since we became aware that many SIS vendors don't trigger the sending of the grade record when a student has withdrawn from a course, we've updated this rule to apply only to CTE courses in Carl Perkins districts, where the grade requirement is the most important for reporting.</p> <p>This change applies to WISEdata v2.0 for 2018-19 school year data and earlier. The original issue does not apply to v3.0 data.</p>
<p>WDP: Child Count export improvements</p>	<p>We've made the following updates to the Child Count export:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Special education data now appears if a SPED record exists for a student but the student's school-level demographics haven't been submitted. ● Disability column has been renamed to Child Count Disability Status.
<p>WDP: Roster Sections - Grades/Marks export now includes Grade ID</p>	<p>Per user request, the Grade ID now appears in a column in the Roster Sections - Grades/Marks export to help clean up grade data in a SIS.</p>

WDP: Bug Fix - Rules 6503 and 6575 no longer throw for inactive WISEids	Previously, rules 6503 and 6575 could throw for WISEids that had been merged. This issue is now fixed.
WDP: Bug Fix - Errors 7112 and 7113 now clear correctly	Previously, errors 7112 and 7113 didn't clear if a student had a subsequent enrollment. This issue is now fixed.
WDP: Bug Fix - Performance improvement for rule 7114	Previously, rule 7114 could time out before it could finish running. This issue is now fixed.
