<p>WDP: Special Education Data Export now includes a column for all reported disabilities</p>	<p>We've added a new column to the Special Education Data Export that shows all of a student's reported disabilities so that it's easier to verify that all students with reported disabilities are correctly identified. This new information appears next to the existing DPI Reported Disability column.</p>
<p>WISEadmin Portal: Users with access to multiple agencies can now change agencies in WISEadmin Portal</p>	<p>Users who can log into multiple agencies, such as CESA users, can now change agencies without logging out of WISEadmin Portal. To do so, select your name in the upper-right, then click Change Agency in the menu.</p>
<p>WDP: Performance improvement for validation rule 6503</p>	<p>Previously, validation rule 6503 could cause validation jobs to take a long time to run. This performance issue is now fixed.</p>
<p>WDP: Bug Fix - Validation rule 7114 now throws an error when appropriate</p>	<p>Previously, validation rule 7114 could miss throwing an error when a student's exit type is TC but there is no future enrollment for that student. This issue is now fixed and the rule now throws an error when appropriate.</p>
<p>Ed-Fi Credential: Bug Fix - Clicking the DPI logo now opens WISEhome</p>	<p>Previously, clicking the DPI logo didn't take a user to WISEhome, as it would in other DPI web applications. This issue is now fixed.</p>
