WDP: Special Education Data Export now includes a column for all reported disabilities	We've added a new column to the Special Education Data Export that shows all of a student's reported disabilities so that it's easier to verify that all students with reported disabilities are correctly identified. This new information appears next to the existing DPI Reported Disability column.
WISEadmin Portal: Users with access to multiple agencies can now change agencies in WISEadmin Portal	Users who can log into multiple agencies, such as CESA users, can now change agencies without logging out of WISEadmin Portal. To do so, select your name in the upper-right, then click Change Agency in the menu.
WDP: Performance improvement for validation rule 6503	Previously, validation rule 6503 could cause validation jobs to take a long time to run. This performance issue is now fixed.
WDP: Bug Fix - Validation rule 7114 now throws an error when appropriate	Previously, validation rule 7114 could miss throwing an error when a student's exit type is TC but there is no future enrollment for that student. This issue is now fixed and the rule now throws an error when appropriate.
Ed-Fi Credential: Bug Fix - Clicking the DPI logo now opens WISEhome	Previously, clicking the DPI logo didn't take a user to WISEhome, as it would in other DPI web applications. This issue is now fixed.
