<p>WDP: Modified Count Inclusion logic for rule 6376</p>	<p>We modified the Count Inclusion calculation for validation rule 6376, so WISEdata will set the Count Inclusion status to 'No' for TFS and Oct. 1 count dates when a school has the 6376 Invalid Grade Level error. The updated Count Inclusion calculated value will appropriately display in the exports and Student Details for the student.</p>
<p>EdCred: Allow sped-only vendors to view Discipline data</p>	<p>Special education vendors, such as OASYS, need to be able to pull in Discipline data to accommodate some of the special education processing and providing a convenience to users not having to go into their SIS for this. We modified the Ed-Fi Credential authority for these sped-only vendors to have read-only access for Discipline data.</p>
<p>WDP: Bug Fix--Enrollments now display correctly.</p>	<p>We had a bug for a couple districts where invalid enrollments were showing up on the Student Details screen in the WISEdata Portal when they shouldn't. This was resolved.</p>
<p>WDP: Bug Fix--Student Academic Record displays correctly.</p>	<p>We fixed a bug on the Student Details screen in the WISEdata Portal where the Student Academic Record wasn't displaying for some Choice schools.</p>
