<p>WDP: Validation rules 6770 and 6771 now check for a Grade record for any students with a primary enrollment with a grade of 9-12 (applies to 2019-20 data and later)</p>	<p>We've updated validation rules 6770 and 6771 to check for a Grade record for any student with a primary enrollment in grade 9-12. As a result of this change, if a school is submitting a non-primary coursework enrollment for a student whose primary enrollment elsewhere has a grade 9-12, and the non-primary school submits Roster data, that school must submit data elements as though the student is in grade 9-12.</p> <p>This change applies to the v3 versions of these rules, which apply to data from the 2019-20 school year and later.</p>
<p>WDP: Validation message sorting by school now available</p>	<p>Previously, a user couldn't sort validation messages on the validation grid by school. Now, you can sort by school by clicking the header in the School column.</p>
<p>WDP: Bug Fix - Message icon no longer appears in Roster section when there is no validation message</p>	<p>Previously, the icon indicating a validation message could appear in the Roster section of the Student Detail screen when there was no error to trigger it. This issue is now fixed.</p>
<p>WDP: Bug Fix - Validation rules 6393, 6613, 6725, 6752, and 6760 now show details appropriately in validation message grid</p>	<p>Previously, when certain validation rules showed validation messages in WISEdata Portal, no details appeared in the validation message grid. This issue is now fixed. This applies to the following validation rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 6393 ● 6613 ● 6725 ● 6752 ● 6760

<p>WDP: Bug Fix - Validation rule 6510 now correctly includes only ETC exit types</p>	<p>Validation rule 6510 is intended to only include students with an exit type of ETC. Previously, it could show an error for students with other exit types. This issue is now fixed.</p>
<p>WDP: Bug Fix - Validation rule 6396 now shows an error when expected</p>	<p>Previously, validation rule 6396 could show an error when a student's first and last name match their WISEid and there is no name suffix. This issue is now fixed.</p>
