WISEadmin Portal: Updates to submitting data errata in WISEadmin Portal	To make it easier to submit data errata through WISEadmin Portal, we've made the following updates: • You can now submit multiple separate data errata letters for the same data category. An error no longer appears if a letter has already been submitted for a data errata category. • Approved data errata letters no longer have the Remove button and cannot be removed. Approved letters should remain in WISEadmin Portal for easy reference.
WDP: Change to CTE Participant calculation	As part of adjustments to data reporting for COVID-19, we've changed how DPI calculates which students are CTE participants for the 2019-20 school year. After this change, a student counts as a CTE participant for a Carl Perkins district if the student is enrolled in a CTE course with an attempt status of Sufficient, regardless of the student's outcome. This change has also been applied to which students are included in the CTE Participants export in WISEdata Portal.
WDP: Update to validation rule 6649 (2019-20 school year and later)	Validation rule 6649 shows an error message if a student is three years old and has an enrollment type of PPP because pre-K and K3 students should not be submitted as PPP. However, to account for scenarios in which a three-year-old student could be in a 4K

	grade, we've updated the rule to also check for a PK or K3 grade level and avoid false positives.
WDP: Update to Student Details page to add Term Completion Indicator labels	We've updated field labels on the Student Details screen in WISEdata Portal to make it clear which fields show a student's Term Completion Indicator.
WDP: Bug Fix - Staff count in Course Offerings export	Previously, the Course Offerings Roster export in WISEdata Portal could show an incorrect number in the Staff Count column. This issue is now fixed.
WDP: Bug Fix - Grade Level and Exit Type columns for prior year enrollments on Student Details page	Previously, when you view a student's prior year enrollments on the Student Details page, the data in the Grade Level and Exit Type columns could be swapped. This issue is now fixed.
