WDP: WISEdata Portal updated to v.3.0.	The WISEdata Portal has been updated to version 3.0, with significant interface changes and updates to data reporting and data elements. You can see an overview of some of these changes in the WISEdata Portal v.3.0 Upgrade Overview .
WDP: Enhancement--Consolidated Career Education Programs export.	The Certified/Non-Certified Career Education Programs export now includes both course-related and non-course related Career Education student program associations so you can more easily review submitted career education data.
WDP: Bug Fix--Rule 6783 now throws for the correct categories of students.	Validation rule 6783 now appropriately throws only for students without an IAC Code Type and who are in grades 11 or 12 with a primary enrollment in the school that submitted SCTEPA for that school year.
WDP: Bug Fix--Rules 6784 and 6789 now throws for the correct categories of students.	Validation rules 6784 and 6789 now appropriately throws only for students in grades 11 or 12 with a primary enrollment in the school that submitted SCTEPA for that school year.
WDP: Bug Fix--Rules 6790, 6791, 6794, 6795, and 6796 now throw for the correct categories of students.	Validation rules 6790, 6791, 6794, 6795, and 6796 now appropriately throw only for students in grades 9-12 with a primary enrollment in the school that submitted SCTEPA for that school year.
WDP: New WISEdata validation rules	We added the following new validations:

WDP: Improved performance for validation rules.	The job queue now processes validation rules more quickly for improved performance.
