<p>WDP: Added the ability to view different school years on the Student Detail screen without leaving the page <i>UserVoice feature request</i></p>	<p>We've added a new drop-down menu to the Student Detail screen that lets you easily select which school year you want to view that student's WISE information for.</p>
<p>WDP: Added the ability to acknowledge warnings from the Student Detail screen <i>UserVoice feature request</i></p>	<p>You can now save time while viewing a student's information in the WISEdata Portal by acknowledging warnings directly from the Student Detail screen. To do so:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● On the Student Detail screen, expand a section with an unacknowledged warning. Sections with validation errors or unacknowledged warnings are indicated by a yellow envelope icon. ● In the Validation Message section, click Acknowledge to acknowledge the warning.
<p>WDP: CTE participant exports no longer include school name or school ID</p>	<p>CTE participant exports are frequently used to see the count of CTE students at a district. However, students enrolled at multiple schools could be counted multiple times. To ensure a more accurate count, the school name and school ID are no longer included in these exports.</p>
<p>WDP: Added validation rule to check for primary enrollments when non-primary enrollments exist</p>	<p>We've added validation rule 7094, which fires when a student has a non-primary enrollment but no primary enrollment exists for that student.</p>
<p>WDP: Revised validation rules that check the next school year</p>	<p>We've updated the following validation rules so that they properly check for the next</p>

	school year: 6509, 6582, 6503, 6575, 6510, 6576, 6726, 6727
WDP: Revised validation rule 6391	Validation rule 6391 now only fires when a student has disability information submitted but no disability is marked as primary.
WDP: Validation rule 6631 now also checks for null district of residence	Validation rule 6631 now also fires when a student's district of residence is blank.
