

Residential Care Facility (RCC): WISEstaff Reporting Guidance

General Guidance

All RCC teachers providing education to **public school students** are required to be reported in the WISEstaff data collection and should be licensed to teach the assignments reported.

The school/district where an RCC enrolled student is receiving the educational service/program should report the teachers teaching these students.

Staff providing instruction to Parentally Placed Private students are not required to be reported, even though parentally placed private (PPP) school students need to be reported in WISEdata.

The WISEstaff submitting LEA is not responsible for a student without an IEP who is placed in an RCC for illness/medical issues by their parents. Assignment Codes for FAPE Responsible LEA


LEA responsible for reporting RCC teachers should use the following assignment codes:

Regular Education Teachers:

- Code as Assignment Position 53 and normal Assignment Area Code AND -
- Answer, "YES," to the Alternative Education question, "Is this assignment part of a School Board approved alternative education Program?" - AND -
- Answer, "Yes," to the question, "Is this assignment begin performed by a subcontracted individual or a teacher of RCC public school students?"
 - Selecting "Yes" to this question means that WISEstaff Contract information is **not** required to be reported for this assignment.

Special Education Teachers:

- Use WISEstaff Assignments 53-0800 Cross Categorical or 53-0830 Emotional Behavioral Disability (EBD) Assignment for Special Education - AND -
- Answer, "Yes," to the question, "Is this assignment begin performed by a subcontracted individual or a teacher of RCC public school students?"
 - Selecting "Yes" to this question means that WISEstaff Contract information is not required to be reported for this assignment.
