| WISEid: Add performance logging to the WISEsearch service | Added performance monitoring so that we can track system performance including in user interface actions. |
| STAFF: Hotfix Fix Assignment EF Performance Boost Toggle | Assignment Uploads were faulting. We fixed issues and already deployed as a hotfix. |
| STAFF: 21st Century Prep valid schools not working correctly | For a while 21st Century Prep was not working properly for the 14-15 Staff Recollection. Issue was resolved. |
| WISEid: Fix Person Upload for large files when all performance toggles are on | Fixed issues so we can re-enable WISEid performance boots again. |
| STAFF: Fix Assignment UI Errors | Fixed issue so assignment validation in UI in Assignment Edit sections so that messages reflect the current state of the data. |
| STAFF: Create file download of Staff List | Created a CSV file download of the Staff List. |
| WISEid: Add Missing Data Field (Columns and Data) from File Upload and Download Final Version | Standardized Person downloads to reflect new Person Upload fields. |
| WISEid: Redact Choice DHS and DOC Person Audit Data | Hide Local Person ID Person Change History changes of DHS, DOC and Choice Schools for other agencies. |
| STAFF: Statewide validation running at random times | Statewide validation was running at random times because system times out during the night. We created a program to keep the application awake 24 hours per day so jobs run at night as they should. |
| WISEid: Hotfix Removed Person Upload validation for Birth City and Birth State cannot be null | We were incorrectly requiring Birth City and Birth State. We fixed and deployed already as Hotfix. |
| WISEid: Hotfix Student Person Upload Faults in Production | Person Uploads were faulting in production. We fixed issue. |
