Parent/Guardian Data No Longer Appears for Prior School Years

WISEdata now collects and displays parent and guardian data starting in the 2021-22 school year. However, these fields also appeared for prior school years, which caused confusion around what years this data was required for. Now, parent and guardian data appears only for the 2021-22 school year.

Graduation Plan Updates for DOC Schools

Wisconsin Department of Corrections schools now see the graduation plan UI elements required to validate graduation plan data, including validation message details in the Validation Message grid.

Bug Fixes

Bug fixes in this release include:

- Fixed an issue that could cause student and staff counts for the 2020-21 school year on the School Roster Details tab to appear as 0.
- Fixed an issue that could cause <u>validation error 7139</u> to appear when it should not.
- Fixed an issue that could cause <u>validation warning 7167</u> not to appear when it should.
