

WISEdata Updates

WISEdata Portal: Critical Errors

On the WISEdata Portal (WDP) Agency menu, Validation Messages screen a new checkbox is being made available for Critical Errors. Checkboxes already exist for Errors and Warnings, but this new checkbox option will specifically display a list of critical errors.




As a reminder, critical errors are the most severe type of validation. All data corrections, for all types of validations, must and can only be corrected by the LEA within their student information system (SIS) vendor tool; WDP is a 'read-only' application.

- Critical errors are data that flowed from your SIS into WDP, but that cannot flow into WISEdash (also referred to as the data warehouse – DW).
 Snapshot data is retrieved from WISEdash, so critical errors must be resolved if this data is to be represented in an LEAs snapshot data. Once a snapshot occurs, the data in that snapshot cannot be edited.
- Errors are data that flowed from your SIS to WDP, but it doesn't look right. Errors may need to be resolved with the help of other LEAs (e.g., overlapping enrollments).
- Warnings are indicators of questionable data. Frequently, warnings will throw around "0" data or "100%" data (e.g., 100% perfect attendance, or zero discipline incidents). This data should be reviewed, as it could very well be correct. If it is correct, acknowledge the warning.

WISEdata Portal: Removing State Endorsed Regional Career Pathway Status


The "State Endorsed Regional Career Pathway Status" (SERCP) data element was deprecated upon completion of the 2019-20 school year. Since this data element has not been used for a number of years and is no longer relevant, it is being removed from the few places where it is still visible on WDP:

- WISEdata Portal Exports, "Validation Message Other Programs": The column for SERCP is being removed from this export.
- CTE Program Ed-Fi API View & the User Interface: for the programs listed on a specific Student Detail screen.



WISEdata Portal: Removing Export Type 'Possible Full-Term Dropout' and 'Possible Mid-Term Dropout'

The exports named are being removed from the WDP Exports section because they no longer exist. Additionally, LEAs use WISEdash to review this data, and Choice schools use the 'WISEdash Extracts' export to review this data.



WISEdata Portal: Bug Fix

A bug was preventing Third Friday in September (TFS) data from flowing into the data warehouse. A fix was put in place and LEAs should now be able to view this data.

WiSFiP: Edit the Pupil Count Category Handle for Residency Status

LEAs were sending student enrollment records with the Residency Status marker 'R', but these students were not being reflected in their headcounts on WiSFiP. The

portal was adjusted so that when the Residency descriptor status is either not supplied (i.e., left blank) or submitted with the value 'R,' the handle of 'R-HC' appears, indicating the student should be included in the Resident Head Count. This change will be occurring across all applicable tabs within WiSFiP.



KBAs for Validations

Validation Error 7478

<u>Error 7478</u> is a new validation that encompasses and replaced errors 6974, 6975 and 6976. This error throws when languages submitted are no longer used, or are listed on the "Obsolete Language Table," which is linked on the <u>Native Language data element page</u>.

Validation Warning 7480

Warning 7480 is a new validation that throws when a new ELP code is submitted or when there is a change in the ELP code by a Choice school with no available data in the prior school year from ACCESS test scores.
