### WISEdata Updates –

#### **WISEdata Portal: Exports, Economic Status, and Food Service Eligibility**

Reporting Economically Disadvantaged Status is an important part of each December snapshot. DPI is happy to provide our customers with a new export that will make your data reporting life easier – the ES/FS Eligibility Export! Prior to this export, multiple exports had to be cross referenced to verify data. This new export will run for the 2023-24 school year and onwards. Student demographic data elements included in this export are:

- School Year
- LEA ID
- LEA Name
- School ID
- School Name
- WISEid
- SSA Entry & Exit Date: *LEAs asked for enrollment end dates to the export so they can easily remove inactive enrollments to make reviewing still currently enrolled students easier.*
- Economically Disadvantaged Status
- DPI Economically Disadvantaged Status (this is a calculated outcome)
- School Food Service Program
- School Food Service Begin and End Date

#### **WISEdata Portal: Exports, Digital Equity Data**

Reporting Digital Equity Data is a recommended – not required - part of the December snapshot. For schools/districts that are eager to report this important data, DPI is happy to provide our customers with a new export that will make your data reporting life easier – the Digital Equity Data Export! This new export will run for the 2023-24 school year and onwards. Student demographic data elements included in this export are:

- School Year
- LEA ID
- LEA Name
- School ID

- Internet Access in Residence

### **WISEdata Portal: Exports, Language of Instruction**

The Course Offerings export now displays a new column labeled as: Language of Instruction, appearing after the 'World Language Category' column. This data element was added for the 2023-24 school year. The export will allow LEAs to compare and verify this data. Language of Instruction is defined on the export as: **the primary language in which instruction is delivered. The Language of Instruction should not be the learner's primary language. If an instruction language is not provided, DPI assumes the language of the course is English.**

### **WISEdata Portal: NEW! Overlapping Enrollments Screen**

This new Overlapping Enrollments screen is located under the Resources tab. This screen is designed to streamline the process of identifying and managing overlapping student enrollments within and between LEAs. These enrollments are associated with various validation messages ([6469](#), [6373](#), and [6374](#)) which help LEAs to quickly understand the validation messages being triggered in other LEAs.

### **WISEdata Portal: Warning Acknowledgments Feature Improved**

UI enhancements to the Warning Acknowledgment feature have been released, improving its functionality and usability.

### **WISEdata Portal: Emergency Bug Fix, Choice Student Report Card Status**

The Report Card Private school (RCP) attribute in WISEdata Portal was displaying incorrectly (true value should have been IN, but Ed-Fi was displaying OUT) for some schools prior to snapshot. This bug has been fixed, and the data is now displaying properly.

### **WISEdata Portal: Emergency Bug Fix, AP Courses for 22/23 and 23/24**

The course program for AP Computer Science Principles attribute in WISEdata Portal was displaying incorrectly (download was displaying n/a when true value was Advanced Placement) for some schools prior to snapshot. This bug has been fixed, and the data is now displaying properly.

### **WISEdata Portal: Bug Fix, Indicator 11**

The SpEd Indicator 11 export in WISEdata Portal was downloading with blank/empty fields. This bug has been fixed, and the export is now downloading all data properly.

## **Ed-Fi Credential Updates –**

### **Ed-Fi: Vendors to Manage Contact Information**

Vendor managers are now responsible for managing their own contact information within the Ed-Fi Credential application. These users can edit and update their contact information directly in the application, which will then be visible to DPI staff and LEAs. This will improve accuracy, allow information to be timelier, and reduce work from DPI staff.

Ed-Fi users with the Admin user role can view this information about the vendors and their contact information on a new screen: 'Vendor Contacts.' This allows for improved ease of use so that users do not have to switch to different screens to view different vendors. This screen displays a table that can be filtered, sorted, and exported. The table displays:

- Vendor name
- First name
- Last name
- Job title
- Role – multiple role names are separated by a comma
- Email address
- Phone number

## **Ed-Fi: Improved Email Notifications**

Ed-Fi Credential application is now displaying vendor contacts who are assigned a primary role. These primary contact persons will receive email notifications when their customers make changes like: adding, updating, or canceling their subscriptions. Vendor contacts will then know of these changes and can support their LEAs through those changes.
