WISEdata Portal (WDP) Updates -

L2 Updates:

- A number of L2s are getting updated for the 2023-24 school year:
 - Error 7447 is replacing Error 7155 for the 2023-24 school year. Error 7155 will no longer be used after the 2022-23 school year has ended. Discipline data is now combining student behavior type and incident type for WISEdata reporting and WISEdata Portal exports.
 - <u>Error 7448</u> is replacing <u>Error 6685</u> for the 2023-24 school year going forward due to a change in behavior data collection endpoint association. Additionally, the Logic for 6685 was adjusted to reflect that students will be reported with an Out-of-School Suspension (OSS action) until the expulsion hearing can take place.
 - The logic for <u>Error 7145</u> was adjusted to match the current API version. This L2 is not being replaced; failing to previous update the API was an oversight which is now resolved.
 - The logic for <u>Error 7191</u> around World Language has been enhanced to split grades 7 & 8 from grades 9-12 so that the error throws with greater accuracy between middle school grades and high school grades.

Bug Fixes:

• The Graduation Plan was not displaying in WISEdata Portal for DoC agencies. This has been corrected.

Export Updates:

• The **Student Section Associations Export** now contains information on students grade level. The Student Section Associations without Grades is being eliminated.

WiSFiP Pupil Count Application Updates:

- Changes have been made to 4K data in the WiSFiP application for year two of the Pilot.
 - The Home page and the Preview page (Review/Refresh Data) page: now includes information on students enrolled in 4K.
 - The Summary pages for each Count Date (Third Friday of September and the Second Friday of January; the First Friday of May as well, but only for Milwaukee School District) now also includes information on students enrolled in 4K.
 - This information is displayed to reflect students under both sets of hours for a 0.5 FTE enrollment at 437 hours, and for a 0.6 FTE enrollment at 524.5 hours.
