WISEdata Portal (WDP) Updates -

Export Updates:

The following Exports have been created in WISEdata Portal for the 2023-24 school year onwards:

- The “Membership Pupil Count” export has been added to WISEdata Portal Exports. You can locate this Export with the Category Type - “All Enrollment”.
- “Pupil Count 2nd Friday of January” is now an Export in WISEdata Portal. This export reports enrollment record submitted by your districts that covers the 2nd Friday of January.
- “Pupil Count 3rd Friday of September” is now an Export in WISEdata Portal. This export reports enrollment record submitted by your districts that covers the 3rd Friday of September.
- New definitions that go along with both the 1st Friday of May, the 2nd Friday of January, the 3rd Friday of September new export include:
 - **Residency Status Begin Date:** The month, day, and year on which an individual enters and begins to receive residency services on the campus for the school year.
 - **Residency Status End Date:** The month, day, and year of the first day after the date of an individual's last receiving service at a school (if known), the day on which an individual graduated, or the date on which it becomes known officially that an individual left school or the date a student died whichever comes first. For continuing students, the exit date is the last day of attendance for the school year.
 - **Resident LEA ID:** This is the LEA id of the resident school.

Validation (L2) Updates:

- [Error 7193](#) has been updated to exclude detention facility schools. This is mentioned in the ‘business rule logic’ on the KBA.

Acknowledgement Page:

- The Acknowledgement page on WISEadmin was showing the message, "There was a severe error." This has been corrected and is displaying normally again.
