

## Release Notes for 7/26/2022

**Ed-Fi Credential Now Excluding Acknowledged Warnings from the LEA Monitoring page -**  
An update in logic on the Ed-Fi Credential application will help LEAs prioritize L2 validation messages. Once a warning is acknowledged, it will no longer appear in the L2 Record Count. As such, LEAs will now only see unacknowledged warnings and errors listed that still need to be resolved.

### **L2 Validation Updates -**

**[Error 7094](#)** - (Connected to WiSFIP Pupil Count for Membership Pilot Program) This error applies to home-based private education (homeschool) or private school students who take up to two classes in a resident public school. Students in this scenario are given a Coursework (C) enrollment type, which is a non-primary enrollment type, by the public school offering the courses. Students are only submitted for accountability when they have a primary enrollment type. However, for non-primary enrollment, Coursework students need to be reported for membership. This error will not throw for Coursework students with a non-primary enrollment when their residency status is residential-private (NR-PRIVATE), resident-home (R-HOME), or non-resident-home (NR-HOME). Contact the school district where the student receives primary education services and ensure that they submit a primary enrollment for the student.

**[Error 7442](#)** - This error throws when the discipline date for a suspension (either in-school or out-of-school) occurs after the enrollment period has ended. Suspensions and other disciplinary actions must occur during the school enrollment period. To clear the warning, ensure that the dates entered for both: (1.) the enrollment term, and (2.) the discipline action have been correctly entered. Correct dates as needed, so that the discipline action date falls within the student's enrollment period.
