# **WISEdata Updates**

#### WISEdata Portal: SATA Removed

The option for "State Assessment Type – Alternate" (SATA) has been removed from the WDP Student Demographic export. This data was last collected in the 2021-22 school year.

#### WISEdata Portal: New Information Icons Added

The Graduation Plan screen in WDP has been upgraded. New features include: An information icon (①) is added to "Credits of Health Education Requirement fulfilled in grade 7 &/or 8." Clicking this icon opens in informational message that reads:

The 0.5 health credit requirement may be met in grade 7 and/or grade 8, provided that the health class is one semester in length and is taught by a licensed health teacher.

An information icon (①) is added to "WI Minimum Graduation Requirement." Clicking this icon opens in informational message that reads:

WI minimum required credits for graduation is 15 credits and recommended is 23.5 credits. WI minimum graduation requirement does not apply to independent charter schools. The 15 credits include the following:

English/Language Arts - 4 Credits

Math - 3 Credits
Science - 3 Credits
Social Studies - 3 Credits
Physical Education - 1.5 credits
Health - 0.5 credits (in grades 7-12)

## WISEdata Portal: L1 Error Download Capability Added

WDP has added a new feature allowing LEAs to download/export API L1's. an "L1" validation refers to a data flow problem within a SIS vendor tool, based on the logic in the SIS and the data entered into the SIS by the LEA. This feature is handy because it allows LEAs to gather a collection of their SIS level data flow problems in one click, instead of copying and pasting them one at a time.

This new feature is named, "Export API Errors." You can locate this feature on WISEdata Portal > Agency Menu > Home tab > Data Pipeline Status > Vendors > Vendor/WISEdata Communication Status.

The export does have limitations: it will only display the top 20,000 error by each date. The export currently contains the following column headers:

# WiSFiP: Continued Updates and Improvements for 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the Pupil Count Pilot

**School Name Displayed:** The TFS, SFJ, and FFM screens now have a column displaying the school's name. The school name also now appears as a column on the corresponding exports.

**Upload Button Added:** When manual entries need to be entered in WiSFiP (e.g., for 3-year-old Programs), an upload file button has been added to ease this manual entry. Users can now upload a .CSV file. The file can contain both the students' WISEid and Local Person ID. There are also radio buttons to select either one or both WISEid, Local Person ID. This function has been added to all Count Date pages.

**NOTE:** Validations have been built into these uploads. If the file uploaded contains a WISEid that is not exactly 10-digits, an error message will display. If an invalid or duplicated WISEid for that school year is uploaded for, an error message will display.

## WISEdata Finance Portal: Overall Improvements to Responsiveness The WISEdata Finance (WDF) Portal was modified so that CESAs and other collaborating agencies can enter their financial data into their vendor tool.

## Warning 7190

Warning 7190 displays around World Language courses for students in grades 6 or higher. A bug was causing the warning to display for students in grades below grade 6 (i.e., PK). This bug was fixed, and the validation is now working as expected.

## Warning 7440

Warning 7440 displays around World Language courses for students in grades 5 or lower. A bug was causing the warning to not display for students in grades below grade 5 (i.e., PK). This bug was fixed, and the validation is now working as expected.

#### Error 7478 - NEW for 2023-24 SY

<u>Error 7478</u> displays when LEAs select Native languages which is no longer used or are obsolete. The KBA links out to the <u>Native Language data element page</u>. #### Error 7479 - NEW for 2023-2 SY
